Commercialization Support

- **SBIR/STTR Transition Program (STP)**
 - Offered exclusively to DON SBIR/STTR Phase II award recipients
 - Eleven months long culminating at Forum for SBIR/STTR Transition
- **Commercialization Readiness Program (CRP)**
 - DON sets aside approximately 20% of its annual SBIR funding
 - DON CRP invested over \$510M into 276 projects since FY06
- **Phase III Guidebook**
 - Comprehensive guidance on using Phase III tool
 - Resource for small/large businesses
- **Rapid Innovation Fund (RIF)**
 - Source selection preference for small businesses
 - Awardees may receive up to \$3M in funding; POP up to 24 mos.



SBIR/STTR Transition Program (STP)

- Goal: Increase commercialization success of DON SBIR/STTR firms
- Objectives:
 - Facilitate DoD use of Navy-funded SBIR/STTR technology
 - Accelerate technology transition to Phase III
- About the Program:
 - Offered exclusively to DON SBIR/STTR Phase II award recipients
 - Eleven months long culminating in Forum for SBIR/STTR Transition
 - DON provides via contractor:
 - Expert business consultant and market research
 - Assistance with developing transition strategy and commercial markets



Commercialization Readiness Program (CRP)

- Created by Congress in FY06
- Goal: Accelerate transition of SBIR/STTR technology to Phase III
- DON sets aside approximately 20% of its annual SBIR funding
- Selection process is very rigorous
 - Validation of DON requirement, technology maturity & firm capabilities
 - Matching funds (non-SBIR/STTR \$) investment is required
- DON CRP invested over \$510M into 276 projects since FY06
 - Return on Investment since FY06:
 - \$327M in direct government funding (Phase III); and
 - \$526M in non-government funding (reported in CCR)



Phase III Guidebook

- Developed by DON SBIR/STTR
 - Assist Program Managers, Contracting Officers, and Small Business professionals
- Comprehensive guidance on using Phase III tool
- Resource for small/large businesses

DON Rapid Innovation Fund (RIF)

- Goal: Accelerate the fielding of innovative technologies into military systems
- Objectives:
 - Enhanced military capability
 - Accelerated military development capability
 - Cost savings to acquisition programs and fielded systems
- About the Program:
 - Source selection preference for small businesses
 - Technology Readiness Level (TRL) 5 - 6
 - Two Step Selection Process
 - Awardees may receive up to \$3M in funding
 - Period of performance of up to 24 months
