Features of www.USPTO.gov

- Apply Online for a Patent using EFS-Web
- Obtain Status of a Patent Application (must be a registered user to see the status of unpublished applications)
- Determine when applications will be picked up for examination, see First Office Action Estimator
- Search US Patent Database
- Search Patent Classification Manual

Features of www.USPTO.gov

- Download Forms and Fee Schedules
- Patent Help Resources
- Access Details of All Currently Pending Published Patent Applications (Public PAIR)
- IP Awareness Assessment Tool
- Information about Pro Se and Pro Bono programs
- Link to StopFakes.gov site
